ACTIVITY: DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

WHAT YOU NEED: NO SUPPLIES NEEDED

What You Do:

ASK:

- Why do your choices matter?
- If you could ask God for anything today, what would it be?
- How do you think asking the Holy Spirit for help changes the way we make choices?
- What could you ask the Holy Spirit before you have to make a choice?
- What are some wise choices that you think Jesus lived out?
- What do you think it means to "build" your life on godly wisdom?

PRAYER

Thank You Lord for guiding us and leading us in all choices when we turn toward you. Help us to trust in you and your plan because you are a good and wise Father. Help us to be wise and live our lives in a way that honors you. In Jesus' name. Amen!"



ACTIVITY: WISDOM OBSTACLE COURSE

WHAT YOU NEED: PAPER, PENCIL, BIBLE, HOUSEHOLD ITEMS LIKE PILLOW, CHAIRS, BLANKET, ETC

What You Do:

- Build a fun indoor or backyard obstacle course with things to climb over, crawl under, jump through, or zigzag around.
- Along the path, tape or place "Choice Cards." On each card, write a situation that needs a wise choice. Examples:
 - "A friend takes your toy — what do you do?"
 - "You see trash on the floor — what's the wise thing?"
 - "You could tell a secret or stay quiet — what honors God?"
 - "You want to say something mean when you're upset."
 - "Someone tells a joke that hurts another kid's feelings."
- Add a few silly action moments to keep the course fun and moving!
 - "Spin in a circle three times!"
 - "March like a king while you shout your wise choice!"
- Take turns running through the obstacle course.
- Each time someone reaches a "Choice Card," they must freeze, read (or have someone read) the card, and say out loud what the wise choice would be.
- Only after answering can they continue through the course! Celebrate every wise answer with a big "WISE CHOICE!" cheer!
- Discuss these questions.
 - Why do you think wisdom matters more than being fast or strong?
 - How do our choices show what's in our hearts — like the kings in the Bible?
 - What can help us make wise choices when things are hard?
