

THE BIBLE TEACHES ME THE BEST THINGS

ACTIVITY: THE BIBLE SAYS

WHAT YOU NEED: BIBLE

What You Do:

- SAY: Let's practice our memory verse for the month.
- SAY: "Your (point up) word (open hands like a book) is truth." (move index finger forward from mouth) John 17:17" (open hands like a book)
- Teach the motions to your child and repeat a few times to help them learn the memory verse and motions.
- Hide the Bible somewhere in the room.
- Have your child search for the Bible. Give them hints similar to the game "Hot and Cold" but instead of saying "hot" and "cold," say "true" and "not true." When your child finds the Bible, have them repeat the memory verse.

• SAY: Jesus' disciples loved teaching other people what God's word means. God's word teaches us the best things, so they wanted people to know more about it. In today's story, we are going to learn how Philip, one of Jesus' disciples, taught someone about God's word.

• Read or summarize Acts 8:26-35

• Play a game of Simon Says with your child.

• Tell your child that if you say "Simon says," before telling them what to do, they must do the action. If you don't, they don't do the action.

• Tell your child to do random things like

- jump real high,
- run in place,
- do jumping jacks,

• After playing for a little bit, give the directions:

- Go find a Bible,
- Hold the Bible up real high,
- Shout, "The Bible teaches me the best things!"

• SAY: The Bible really does teach us the best things! In today's story, we saw how the Holy Spirit told Philip what to do and he did it. He followed God's directions just like you followed my directions. This story teaches us how we should obey what God tells us!

Dear God,

Thank you for all of the things you teach us in the Bible. You teach us about who you are and how to live good lives. You have told us your plans for us and how much you love us. Let me learn more about your word so that I can love you more and talk about you with others. In Jesus' name, Amen!
