ACTIVITY: MEMORY VERSE REVIEW

WHAT YOU NEED: NO SUPPLIES NEEDED

What You Do:

- **SAY:** “We’ve been learning an awesome verse this month. I want us to say the verse together when and ONLY when the lights are on like they are right now! When the lights are off, I want you to stand very still and be very quiet. Are you ready?”
- Review the memory verse and do the following motions with your children.
 - ‘Jesus answered, (hands by mouth) “I am (point up) the way and the truth and the life,” (march) John 14:6. (Open hands like a book.)
- **SAY:** (With lights on) “Now let’s play! Let’s say our verse with the motions.”
 - (Turn lights off.) “Be very still and very quiet.
 - (Turn lights on.) “Let’s say our verse again.”
 - Repeat as desired then leave the lights on.
- **SAY:** That was fun! I love our verse. Jesus is the way, the truth, and the life. He will always help us because He is the best friend ever.
- **ASK:** Who can help you do everything? Jesus can help me do everything.



ACTIVITY: JAR OF GOODNESS

WHAT YOU NEED: JAR/CONTAINER, TOKENS (BEANS, COINS, PAPER, ETC.), MARKERS

What You Do:

- **SAY:** Today we’re starting something special—it’s called our Goodness Jar! Every time you do something good—like helping, sharing, or doing the right thing—we’re going to put a token in our jar! Let’s think of the Fruit of the Spirit we’re learning: Goodness means choosing to do what’s right, even when it’s hard. Can you say, ‘Goodness means doing what’s right!’?”
- **SAY:** “Here’s our Goodness Jar!” “When you do something good or see something good we can add a token to our jar. (You can decide to write the task on paper strips instead to keep record of them in the jar.)
- **SAY:** “Let’s be on the lookout for good acts we can do and then add a token every time we see or do something good! Some examples of things you can do to earn a token are:
 - sharing your toys
 - helping to clean without being asked
 - using kind words
 - telling the truth
- **SAY:** “At the end of each day, let’s look at how many tokens are in the jar! Each one reminds us of how we showed goodness today.”
- At the end of each day, reflect on what was added to the jar or what you may can add that you say or did that day. **ASK:** “Can you remember something you did that was good?”
- Celebrate with your child when they fill the jar. You can celebrate with something fun like a special snack, a game, or a dance party.

PRAYER

Dear God, thank You for sharing Your Son, Jesus, with us so He can be our friend forever and help us do everything. Help us to be good and do good so everyone can see Your goodness in us. We love You, God. In Jesus’ name, amen.”
