ACTIVITY: MEMORY VERSE GAME

WHAT YOU NEED:

NO MATERIALS NEEDED

WHAT YOU DO:

God (point up) saw everything he had made.
(Binocular hands, look around)

And it was very good," (thumbs-up) Genesis 1:31.
(Open hands like a book.)

Say the verse again with the motions and invite the children to do it with you. Repeat several times.

ACTIVITY: Roll The Ball

WHAT YOU NEED:

Playground ball

WHAT YOU DO:

Gather the children to sit in a circle in your activity area. Roll the ball to a child across the circle from you. As you roll say, "God made [child's name]." Then lead the children to say the verse together. Have the child roll the ball back to you. Repeat in the same way, making sure you roll the ball to every child.

Set the ball aside for clean-up.

WHAT YOU SAY:

Friends, stand in a circle here. Good job. Now have a seat. I will roll the ball to a friend, then we'll say the verse together.

God made [child's name]. (Roll the ball to that child.) The Bible teaches us that 'God (point up) saw everything he had made. (Binocular hands, look around) And it was very good,' (thumbs-up) Genesis 1:31. (Open hands like a book.) Great job! (Continue with each child.)

God made every single one of you, and God made me! God made everything. Who made everything? God made everything.
