"What We Build With Matters" Luke 10:33-35

- 33 But a certain Samaritan, as he journeyed, came where he was. And when he saw him, he had compassion.
- 34 So he went to him and bandaged his wounds, pouring on oil and wine; and he set him on his own animal, brought him to an inn, and took care of him.
- 35 On the next day, when he departed, he took out two denarii, gave them to the innkeeper, and said to him, 'Take care of him; and whatever more you spend, when I come again, I will repay you.'

I. Build with a sympathetic love (v.33).

"...he had compassion."

The father son had compassion for his son.

Do we love enough to feel what we see?

II. Build with a sacrificial love (v.34).

"...took care of him."

Johnny gave his blood to his sister.

Do we love enough to give what we have?
