ACTIVITY: MEMORY VERSE REVIEW

WHAT YOU NEED: BUBBLES

What You Do:

- **SAY:** Okay, let's get ready! We're going to play a fun game with bubbles and practice our Memory Verse together.
- Say the memory verse and do the following motions with your children.
 - “God (Flat hand with thumb to forehead, pull down) saw everything he had made (Binocular Eyes) And it was very good.” (Two thumbs up) Genesis 1:31 (Open hands like a book)
- Review the memory verse several times together.
- **SAY:** “Look, bubbles! Let's pretend to be sea animals swimming through the bubbles. As we swim, let's say our verse together. Ready? ‘God saw everything he had made. And it was very good,’ Genesis 1:31.”
- Encourage your child to swim, jump, or crawl through the bubbles. Repeat as many times as your child wants.
- **SAY:** The Bible teaches us that God made everything—light and dark, sky and water, land and seas, plants and animals, the sun, moon, and stars. God made sea animals, birds, and even us. God is so creative because... God made everything!



ACTIVITY: GOD MADE EVERYTHING

WHAT YOU NEED: NO SUPPLIES

What You Do:

- **SAY:** Today we're going to review our song and add a new part to help us remember the first five days of creation. We're going to say a little rhyme and use our hands and bodies to act it out. I'll say a line first, and you copy me and do the motions. Ready? Let's go!
- Child repeats and copies what you do after each line.
- Day 1 – Light and Dark
 - Parent: “Day one, God made the light” (spread arms wide) “He called the darkness ‘night’” (cover eyes with hands)
- Day 2 – Sky and Water
 - Parent: “Day two, God made the sky” (wave arms above head like clouds) “And waters deep and high” (make wavy motion with hands)
- Day 3 – Land and Plants
 - Parent: “Day three, God made the land” (spread hands flat in front of you) “And plants grew where they stand” (slowly rise from crouched position like growing plants)
- Day 4 – Sun, Moon, and Stars
 - Parent: “Day four, God made the sun” (big circle with arms over head) “The moon and stars for everyone” (make a crescent moon shape, then twinkle fingers)
- Day 5 – Birds and Fish
 - Parent: “Day five, God made the fish” (put hands together and wiggle like a fish swimming) “And birds that swoop and swish” (flap arms like wings)
- God is so good and so creative. We will learn what God did on day six and seven next week.
