**ACTIVITY: MEMORY VERSE AND MOTIONS**

WHAT YOU NEED: NO MATERIALS NEEDED

WHAT YOU DO:

- Say the memory verse and do the following motions in front of the child.
- The lord gives wisdom (thumbs to head)  
knowledge (circle hands around head)  
understanding comes from his mouth.  
(point to mouth) Proverbs 2:6.

**ACTIVITY: Have you Heard The News?**

WHAT YOU NEED:

Tray, random objects, and kitchen towel;  
Optional timer

What You Do

- Put the random objects on the tray and cover it with the kitchen towel.
- Set the tray in front of the kids.
- Uncover the tray and give the kids about 20 seconds to look at it.
- When time is up, direct the kids to close and cover their eyes with their hands.
- Remove one item and place it under the towel.
- Direct the kids to uncover their eyes to look at the tray.
- If they think they know what item is missing, instruct the kids to raise their hands.
- Call on a volunteer to answer.
- Continue in the same way, removing one item each round until you get down to three or four items.
