### ACTIVITY: FAMILY PRAYER PATH

**WHAT YOU NEED: PAPER, MARKERS, TAPE, BIBLE**

**What You Do:**

- SAY: Today we're going to learn about The Lord's Prayer. When Jesus was on earth, His friends asked Him how to pray. Jesus gave them a special prayer to teach us how to talk to God. We're going to walk through our house and pray together as a family.
- Write one phrase of the Lord's Prayer on 6 different pieces of paper.
  - Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name
  - Your kingdom come, Your will be done
  - Give us today our daily bread
  - Forgive us our sins, as we forgive those who sin against us
  - Lead us not into temptation
  - But deliver us from evil
- Have the family walk to each station in order. At each stop, read the phrase, talk about it, and pray together.
- Station 1: Everyone says one word that describes God (loving, strong, kind, holy). Pray together.
- Station 2: Each person shares one way they can obey God this week (be kind, tell the truth, help others). Pray together.
- Station 3: Name one thing you are thankful for today (food, home, family, friends) Pray together.
- Station 4: Everyone makes a heart shape with their hands. Explain: Forgiveness means letting go and loving like Jesus. Pray together.
- Station 5: Talk about one thing that can be hard to do the right way (being kind, sharing, obeying). Pray together.
- Station 6: Everyone does a strong pose to remind them God is powerful and protects us.
- Read Matthew 6:9-13 together. Younger children may repeat one line at a time.

### ACTIVITY: DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

**WHAT YOU NEED: NO SUPPLIES NEEDED**

**What You Do:**

**ASK:**

- Why do you think Jesus wanted to give His friends an example of how to pray?
- What surprises you about the idea that God—the Creator of the universe—wants to talk with you?
- What do you think keeps you from praying, from talking to God?
- The Lord's Prayer' includes asking for things like forgiveness and daily needs—it covers all sorts of topics. What's something you could talk to God about this week?
- How could making prayer a regular thing you do—like Jesus did—help you grow closer to God?
