PRAYING WITH PURPOSE "The Priority of Prayer"

James 5:13-14

"Praying will do more to make the Church what it ought to be than anything else we can do." -R.A. Torrey

<u>13 Is</u> anyone among you suffering? Let him pray. Is anyone cheerful? Let him sing psalms.

<u>14 Is</u> anyone among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord.

I. Different times to pray

"...suffering...cheerful...sick..."

Jesus prayed at different times.

When do we pray?

II. Different types of prayer

Let him pray (v.13)- to pour one's heart out to God. And the prayer (v.15)- a wish expressed as a petition to God.
