ACTIVITY: MEMORY VERSE REVIEW

WHAT YOU NEED: MEASURING TAPE

What You Do:

- SAY: Let’s review our new memory verse together.
- SAY: ‘How wide (stretch arms out wide) and long (stretch arms forward) and high (reach arms up) and deep (crouch down low) is the love of Christ. (Hug yourself.) Ephesians 3:18.” (Open hands like a book.)
- SAY: Now, let’s do a quick activity to help us review it. We are going to get a sense of how big God’s love is with this activity. When I say a part of the memory verse, we are going to see how far we can stretch this measuring tape! Are you ready?
- DO: Say the different parts of the memory verse one at a time. When you say, “How wide/long is the love of Christ?” you will have your child stretch the tape measure as far in one direction as they can. When you say, “How high/deep is the love of Christ?” you will help your child stretch the measuring tape as far up or down as they can.
- SAY: That was really big wasn’t it! You see, the love of Christ is SO much bigger than that! And all of that love is for you and for me!



ACTIVITY: SHOW LOVE EVERY DAY!

WHAT YOU NEED: CALENDAR/PIECE OF PAPER, WRITING UTENCIL, COLORING SUPPLIES

What You Do:

- DO: If you do not have a calendar you can use for this activity, you can draw one on a piece of paper. Just make a box 4 rows of 7 days and write Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, etc. on the top of each column to represent the days of the week. You can even number the days of the month on the calendar, however, this is not necessary for this activity.
- SAY: In this week’s Bible story (Luke 13:10-17), you heard about how Jesus healed a woman on the Sabbath. The Pharisees were mad at Jesus for this because they thought it was bad to do any work on this day. However, Jesus knows that it’s important to show people love EVERY day!
- SAY: On this paper, we have a calendar. A calendar is how we can see what day it is and what days are coming up. Let’s show that we can care for people every day by coming up with a way we can show people we care for as many days as we can!
- DO: Encourage your child to come up with a bunch of ways to show people that they care about them. Come up with some of your own, too. Write each action on a different day of the calendar or have your child draw each action on a different day. Do this either until the calendar is full or your child loses interest.
