ACTIVITY: MEMORY VERSE PRACTICE

WHAT YOU NEED: NO SUPPLIES NEEDED

What You Do:

- **SAY:** Let’s review our memory verse. It tells us about God’s kingdom, and it goes like this: ‘Put God’s (point up with two hands) kingdom (make crown on head with hands) first.’ (Hold up one finger.) Matthew 6:33 (open hands like a book).”
- **SAY:** Now, let’s review the motions! I’m going to challenge you to see how well you know the motions. I am going to say a part of the memory verse. Your job is too do the motion that goes with that part. So, if I say “Put God’s,” what motion should you do? (point up with two hands)
- **SAY:** Awesome job! Are you ready to go through the verse?
- **DO:** Go through the verse a few times with your child doing the motions. Repeat until you think your child has gotten a solid grasp of the motions to the memory verse.



ACTIVITY: TALENT CHALLENGE

WHAT YOU NEED: PAPER, WRITING SUPPLIES

What You Do:

- **SAY:** This week’s Bible story was about a man who put three slaves in charge of his money while he went away on a journey. Each slave was given a different amount of money; one 5 bags of gold, one 2 bags, and one only 1 bag. The first two made more money with what they were given while the third hid the money away. The master was proud of the first two but was angry with the third.
- **SAY:** In this parable, Jesus was saying that everyone should take the talent they have been given by God and use it to help others!
- **SAY:** Think about something that you are really good at. Now, think about a way you can use that thing to help someone else.
- **DO:** Give your child a few seconds to think quietly.
- **SAY:** What did you think about?
- **SAY:** Awesome! Let’s use this paper to write out a challenge for ourselves. We are going to make a checklist of ways we can use our talents to help others. The challenge is that we will try to do everything on this list by the end of the week. When we do one of them, we will check off that thing. Let’s come up with at least 10 things. Ready?
- **DO:** Take some time to let your child come up with some ways they can use their gifts to help others. Come up with some yourself too and challenge your child and yourself to complete the list by the end of the week.
