## ACTIVITY: MEMORY VERSE REVIEW

WHAT YOU NEED: NO SUPPLIES NEEDED

What You Do:

- SAY: We have a new memory verse for the new month so let's learn it together!
- SAY: “Jesus said (tap finger to middle of each palm) “Let the children (point to children) come to me,” (move hands toward self) Matthew 19:14.” (Open hands like a book.)
- Review the motions with your child and repeat a few times to help them remember the memory verse and motions.
- SAY: The Bible teaches us that Jesus loves all children, and Jesus wants to be our friend forever! That's such an awesome thing, Jesus loves you (point to your child) and Jesus loves me.
- SAY: Who loves you? [Bottom Line] Jesus loves me. That's right! This time when I ask, I want you to say it loud and proud. Who loves you? [Bottom Line] Jesus loves me!”



## ACTIVITY: PATH TO JESUS

WHAT YOU NEED: PAPER, CRAYONS

What You Do:

- SAY: In our Bible story, children came to Jesus. Some people tried to stop them, but Jesus said, ‘Let the little children come to Me.’ Jesus loved the children.
- SAY: Let's make a path to Jesus, just like the children in the story went to Jesus and He made a way for them.
- Help your child trace or stamp their handprints across several pieces of paper in a line.
- Have the child “walk” their fingers (or jump, depending on how many pieces of paper used) along the handprint path toward the parent.
- When the child reaches the end of the handprint path:
  - SAY: Jesus says, “Come to Me.”
  - Give your child a hug.
  - SAY: Jesus loves children.
  - Have your child say “Jesus loves me!”
- Allow children to decorate one or multiple of the pieces of paper with their handprint and write “Matthew 10:13-16” and “Jesus loves children” on the paper for them to keep as a reminder of the story.
