ACTIVITY: TAKE A SNAPSHOT

WHAT YOU NEED: No Supplies Needed

What You Do:

Ask:

Imagine you are going camping with a friend for a weekend.

- What plans do you need to make?
 - Examples could include: What will be your shelter? What will you eat? What will you do for fun?

Ask:

- What if you didn't make any plans for the camping trip? What could happen?

We can make plans, but sometimes things don't go according to our plans, do they?

- Can you think of an example of something that could happen on our camping trip we didn't plan for?
- Why are plans important?

Plans are very important for us to have. But, even if we fail to plan, we can always trust that God has a plan and His plans are always the best.



ACTIVITY: VERSE TO REMEMBER

WHAT YOU NEED: Bible

What You Do:

Read the verse below. Allow your child to read once and then alternate reading a few times with you.

- Proverbs 3:5: Trust in the Lord with all your heart. Do not depend on your own understanding.

Trusting God is often one of the hardest things for us to do. I think one of the reasons is in our verse today in the part where it says, 'depend not on your own understanding.'

Instead of trusting in God, we think we can do it all. We think we know it all or think we don't need to ask God for help. But God is God!

God is almighty, all-powerful, and all-knowing! And God has a plan to make things right with the world.

God sent Jesus to prove how much He loves us and to make a way for us to have a relationship with Him now and forever. You can trust that God has a plan.

Say that with me: You can trust that God has a plan.

Thank You, God, that You love us more than we can imagine. Thank You that You always have a bigger plan in mind, a plan to ultimately show Your love to the world by making things right through Jesus.
