ACTIVITY: DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

WHAT YOU NEED: BIBLE

What You Do:

Ask:

- Do you think having doubts or questions means you're not following Jesus?
- Why or why not?
- What are some reasons people doubt God?

Doubts and questions about God are good because it means you're thinking through really important stuff about life.

- Do you agree or disagree with that statement?
- What's the BEST thing you can do when you have questions and doubts about God?
- What's the WORST thing you can do?



ACTIVITY: MEMORY VERSE

WHAT YOU NEED: BIBLE

What You Do:

Let's look up and read John 16:33 together as a reminder that hard times might come to us, but we can have hope because God sees the big picture.

We should know that hope and faith go hand-in-hand. When we have faith in God, we will always have hope.

- Ask your child to turn to Hebrews 11:1 and ask them to read it aloud.

Don't forget that Thomas had some doubts and questions about Jesus. He felt like he needed to SEE Jesus with his own eyes in order to believe that Jesus was alive. The writer of Hebrews says we can have faith even in things we cannot see.

- Would you say that faith itself is visible or invisible? Why?
- Is faith something we choose, or does it just happen?

PRAYER

Dear God, YOU are the reason we don't have to live with doubts and questions. You have given us the answers to life's questions in the Bible. And You've given us Jesus to show us how to live with faith and hope. You created us to have a relationship with You and made a way for that through Jesus' death and resurrection. You help us when we doubt and have questions. Help us to anchor our hope in YOU—no matter what. In Jesus' name, amen.
