ACTIVITY: MEMORY VERSE PRACTICE

WHAT YOU NEED: NO SUPPLIES NEEDED

What You Do:

- **SAY:** Let's review our memory verse together. First, let's say it one time with the motions.
- **SAY:** “We have seen (point to self) amazing things today! (Hands like binoculars, open and shut.) Luke 5:26 (open hands like a book).
- **SAY:** In this week's bible story, you learned how Jesus healed the servant of a Roman Commander! Isn't that amazing?! Let's review our memory verse by using some silly verses that go with this story!
- **DO:** Go through the memory verse with motions in the following voices:
 - Silly voice
 - Sick voice
 - Commander voice (bold and loud)
 - Soft voice
 - (If you think it would be fun, you can add a few more voices)



ACTIVITY: THE FAITH BUILD

WHAT YOU NEED: BUILDING BLOCKS (LEGOS, CUPS, WOODEN BLOCKS, ETC.)

What You Do:

- **SAY:** The Roman Commander trusted that Jesus would be able to heal his servant without having to see the servant. Let's play a game where we have to trust each other like the Roman Commander trusted Jesus.
- **SAY:** I will go to another room and give you instructions to build something with these blocks. You will not know what I am telling you to build. You just have to follow my instructions the best you can. Do you think you can do that?
- **SAMPLE INSTRUCTIONS:**
 - “Put two blocks side by side.”
 - “Place two more blocks directly on top of those.”
 - “On the bottom layer, leave a small space in the middle.”
 - “Add one block across the very top.”
 - “Put one block on each side of the top block.”
- **SAY:** That was pretty fun! Did you notice how I had to trust that you would be able to build what I wanted you to build, even when I couldn't see you? The Roman Commander had to trust Jesus to heal his servant even though Jesus couldn't see the servant. The difference is this, Jesus can be trusted with everything because he never messes up! He always knows what to do!
