ACTIVITY: MEMORY VERSE REVIEW

WHAT YOU NEED: NO MATERIALS NEEDED

What You Do:

Your memory verse tells us that we can trust God with all our heart. Let's review our memory verse motions together. 'Trust in the Lord (point up) with all (arms out wide) your heart (hands over heart),' Proverbs 3:5." (Open hands like a book.)

ACTIVITY: BIBLE STORY REVIEW

WHAT YOU NEED: NO SUPPLIES NEEDED

What You Do:

In your Bible story this week, began with a man named Moses. Moses was the leader of God's people, the Israelites. The Israelites complained A LOT because they were hungry. We want food! Moses talked to God, and God gave them food to eat.

But the Israelites complained again because they were thirsty. We want water! Moses talked to God, and God gave them water. But the Israelites complained again! They told Moses they wished they were back home!

This made Moses feel very frustrated. Moses knew he could always talk to God, so that's what he did. Moses told God that he felt frustrated and that he didn't know what to do with all the complaining people. God loved Moses and sent him people to help him.

God loved Moses when he was frustrated and sent people to help him. God loves us when we're frustrated, too. We can ALWAYS talk to God because God loves us no matter what. Who loves you no matter what? God loves you no matter what!
