## ACTIVITY: DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

**WHAT YOU NEED: NO SUPPLIES NEEDED**

**What You Do:**

**ASK:**

- What's the difference between being happy and having joy?
- What's one thing you want to ask the Holy Spirit to help you with today?
- Before that Pentecost when God sent the Holy Spirit, the believers were waiting without knowing what would happen. How would YOU feel waiting for something God promised but didn't explain?
- Why does God choose to work through us instead of doing everything Himself?
- Since the Holy Spirit lives in you as a follower of Jesus, what are some ways you hear His voice?

## ACTIVITY: PRETEND PENTECOST

**WHAT YOU NEED: STRAWS, PAPER, AND RED, YELLOW, AND ORANGE COLORING SUPPLIES**

**What You Do:**

- **SAY:** In this week's Bible story, you learned about the day of Pentecost. Tell me what happened on the day of Pentecost.
- **DO:** Give your child a chance to say what they remember from the Bible story. You can prompt them if needed.
- **SAY:** So the Holy Spirit came with two different signs on that day. Those two are fire and wind. Let's act out that moment so we can get an idea of what that was like.
- **SAY:** Let's start with the wind! Grab your straw and start blowing through it! \*Take a moment to blow through straws with your child\* What did you hear? What did you feel? How do you think the disciples felt when they heard a rushing wind?
- **SAY:** Now let's move on to the fire. Take this piece of paper and these crayons, and let's draw fire!
- **SAY:** When the Holy Spirit came upon the disciples, fire appeared above them and landed on them. Let's act that out with the fire we just made!
- **SAY:** This was a very important moment for the Church. The Day of Pentecost is when God gave his church the power to go out and share his love with all people. While we don't get the wind and fire today, we still receive the same Spirit that they did back then! We can be confident that God will always be with us through His Spirit just like he was always with the disciples.
