## ACTIVITY: MEMORY VERSE PRACTICE

WHAT YOU NEED: NO SUPPLIES NEEDED

What You Do:

- **SAY:** Let’s review our Memory Verse. It tells us about God’s kingdom, and it goes like this: ‘Put God’s (point up with two hands) kingdom (make crown on head with hands) first.’ (Hold up one finger.) Matthew 6:33 (open hands like a book).”
- **SAY:** Now, let’s review the memory verse with a challenge! Last week, I said the words, and you said the motions. This week, I am going to do the motions, and you need to tell me what the words are that go with that motion. So if I point up with both hands like this, what do you say?
- **SAY:** Awesome job! Are you ready to go through the verse?
- **DO:** Go through the verse a few times with your child doing the motions. Repeat until you think your child has gotten a solid grasp of the motions to the memory verse.



## ACTIVITY: FORGIVENESS JAR

WHAT YOU NEED: JAR/CUP, MARKERS, COINS

What You Do:

- **SAY:** This week’s parable was about a servant who owed a rich man a lot of money. When the servant begged for forgiveness, the rich man forgave him. However, the servant then went out to meet a man who owed him a little bit of money. He got angry with that man and had him thrown in jail. When the rich man heard about this, he called the servant to himself and had that servant thrown in jail because he couldn’t forgive the other man for even a little money.
- **SAY:** Jesus’ lesson here is that we should forgive others when they wrong us because God forgave us when we wronged him.
- **SAY:** Let’s make ourselves something to help us remember when we should forgive people. We are going to make a forgiveness jar. First, let’s decorate this jar/cup so we can use it as our forgiveness jar.
- **DO:** Take some time to decorate the jar/cup with your child.
- **SAY:** Here’s what we are going to do with this forgiveness jar. Every single time someone does something that makes us mad, we are going to come to this cup, pray for that person, forgive them, and then put a coin in the jar. At the end of the week, we will see a coin for every time we forgave someone this week. We are all going to do this together because we all need to learn to forgive people when they make us mad.

## PRAYER

Dear God,

Thank you, Lord, for forgiving us when we sin. We are not perfect yet, but you promise that we one day will be. God, I pray that you will help us be as forgiving as you are, so we can be more like you. In Jesus’ name, Amen!
