ACTIVITY: DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

WHAT YOU NEED: NO SUPPLIES NEEDED

What You Do:

ASK:

- Why do you think Jesus told this parable? What did He want us to learn?
- Have you ever felt like the older brother in the story?
- Have you ever done something wrong? Is there anything you could do to make God stop loving you?
- What is the requirement to be in God’s kingdom?

ACTIVITY: PRODIGAL’S FATHER RACE

WHAT YOU NEED: STOPWATCH/TIMER

What You Do:

- **SAY:** In this week’s lesson, you learned about the parable of the prodigal son. Can you tell me what happened?
- **SAY:** Awesome! This boy wanted a bunch of money from his dad. When he got the money, he ran away from home and spent it all! When he ran out of money. He ended up working in a pig pen and eating slop with the pigs! That sounds terrible, doesn’t it? One day, he decided to run back to his father. When his father saw him, he threw a big party to celebrate the fact that he returned.
- **SAY:** We are going to try and pretend to be the father when he saw his son. Let’s go outside for this activity.
- **DO:** Go outside to an area where you and your child can run.
- **SAY:** Now, you need to pretend that you’re the father and that you see the prodigal son off in the distance coming back home. You are going to run from *starting point* to *finish point* to go and meet the son. I am going to time you to see how fast you can do it. Are you ready?
- **DO:** Let your child run the race multiple times to see how fast they can go.
- **SAY:** That was super fast! But do you know what’s crazy? God will run so much faster to meet anyone who is trying to come back to him! That’s just how much God loves people!
