What You Do:

ASK:


- What helps you remember that God is with you?
- Would Jacob be someone you would trust all the time? Why or why not? And yet Jacob is part of God's plan. How does that encourage you to trust God, knowing that even when you mess up, God still loves you and is working toward His good plan?
- Abraham and Jacob were part of God's Big Story. What about us?
- How do we fit into God's plan today?
- What does Jacob's story tell us about God's character and His love for us?

PRAYER

Dear God.

Thank You that You have a good plan for us. Thank you for loving us and working through us even when we mess up. Help us to trust in your plan and know that you are good. We love you and we thank you for being an AWESOME God! Amen."







ACTIVITY: GOD IS WITH ME WHAT YOU NEED: PAPER, PENCIL, CRAYONS What You Do:

- SAY: Jacob had a dream where he saw a ladder reaching up to heaven, and he heard God say, 'I am with you and will watch over you wherever you go.'
 We're going to make our own 'Jacob's Ladder' to remind us that God is always with us
- On a piece of paper, have your child draw a tall ladder.
- Ask your child to think of places you go every day.
 For each place, write it on one of the steps of the ladder.
 - Examples: school, home, church, playground, grandma's house, in the car, at bedtime.
- After each place, say together: "God is with me at ___."
- SAY: Just like Jacob learned, no matter where we are, God is right there with us. Now let's take a walk together through the house. At each place, we'll remind ourselves that God is with us there too!
- Walk together into one room and say "God is with us in the living room!" (Kids repeat and cheer, "Yes, He is!")
- Go to another room and say "God is with us in the kitchen!" (Kids repeat and cheer.)
- Keep moving around the house, backyard, or even pretend places (school, playground, doctor's office). Let kids take turns being the leader and announcing: "God is with us in the _ _ _!"
- Discuss situations when your child may feel alone and share how God is with them in those times as well.
