ACTIVITY: DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

WHAT YOU NEED: NO SUPPLIES NEEDED

What You Do:

ASK:

- Why do you think the master in the Bible Story gave different amounts to each servant? Does that seem fair?
- What mattered more to the master—the amount of money the servants earned, or the fact that they were faithful with what they were given? Why?
- The third servant acted out of fear. What are some things that can make us afraid to use our talents or speak up for God or use the opportunities God has given us?
- What has God given you?
- How can trusting God help you take brave steps to use what He’s given you?



ACTIVITY: TALENT CHALLENGE

WHAT YOU NEED: PAPER, WRITING SUPPLIES

What You Do:

- **SAY:** This week’s Bible story was about a man who put three slaves in charge of his money while he went away on a journey. Each slave was given a different amount of money; one 5 bags of gold, one 2 bags, and one only 1 bag. The first two made more money with what they were given while the third hid the money away. The master was proud of the first two but was angry with the third.
- **SAY:** In this parable, Jesus was saying that everyone should take the talent they have been given by God and use it to help others!
- **SAY:** Think about something that you are really good at. Now, think about a way you can use that thing to help someone else.
- **DO:** Give your child a few seconds to think quietly.
- **SAY:** What did you think about?
- **SAY:** Awesome! Let’s use this paper to write out a challenge for ourselves. We are going to make a checklist of ways we can use our talents to help others. The challenge is that we will try to do everything on this list by the end of the week. When we do one of them, we will check off that thing. Let’s come up with at least 10 things. Ready?
- **DO:** Take some time to let your child come up with some ways they can use their gifts to help others. Come up with some yourself too and challenge your child and yourself to complete the list by the end of the week.
