## ACTIVITY: DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

**WHAT YOU NEED: NO SUPPLIES NEEDED**

**What You Do:**

**ASK:**

- Why do you think Nicodemus came to Jesus at night instead of during the day? What does that tell you about his curiosity or fears?
- Jesus said we need to be “born again.” What do you think that means in your own words, and how might your life look different if you let God’s Spirit make you new?
- John 3:16 says God loved the whole world. What are some groups of people or kinds of situations where it’s hardest for you to believe God loves equally—and why?
- Jesus compared the Holy Spirit to the wind—you can’t see it, but you can see what it does. Can you think of a time when you saw evidence of God’s Spirit working in you or someone else?
- Nicodemus had a lot of questions for Jesus, but he didn’t avoid Jesus—he went right to Him with his questions. What does this story teach you about bringing your doubts or questions to God?



## ACTIVITY: LIGHT OF THE WORLD

**WHAT YOU NEED: FLASHLIGHT OR PHONE LIGHT,  
PAPER, CRAYONS**

**What You Do:**

- **SAY:** We are going to review a Bible story about a man named Nicodemus. He came to Jesus at night. Jesus wanted Nicodemus to understand how much God loves the world.
- Give your child a piece of paper and have them fold it in half like a book.
- On the front of your paper, draw the night. This reminds us that Nicodemus came to see Jesus when it was dark.
- **SAY:** On the front of your paper, draw the night. This reminds us that Nicodemus came to see Jesus when it was dark. (Pause while your child draws) Open your paper. Inside, draw a bright light. This reminds us that Jesus is the light God sent.
- Turn off the lights.
- **SAY:** Nicodemus was a teacher who wanted to understand God better. Jesus told him that God gives new life when people believe in Him.
- Turn on the flashlight and shine it onto the inside drawings.
- **SAY:** Jesus explained that God loves the whole world so much that He sent His Son, Jesus. Jesus brings light into the darkness and shows us God’s love.
- **SAY TOGETHER:** Jesus is the light of the world!
- Add the memory verse John 13:34 to the paper.

Thank you Lord for loving the whole world. Thank you for sending Jesus to be our light. Help us to remember to shine your light and love to all those we meet. In Jesus name, Amen!
