ACTIVITY: LIGHT OF THE WORLD

WHAT YOU NEED: FLASHLIGHT OR PHONE LIGHT, PAPER, CRAYONS

What You Do:

- SAY: We are going to review a Bible story about a man named Nicodemus. He came to Jesus at night. Jesus wanted Nicodemus to understand how much God loves the world.
- Give your child a piece of paper and have them fold it in half like a book.
- On the front of your paper, draw the night. This reminds us that Nicodemus came to see Jesus when it was dark.
- SAY: On the front of your paper, draw the night. This reminds us that Nicodemus came to see Jesus when it was dark. (Pause while your child draws) Open your paper. Inside, draw a bright light. This reminds us that Jesus is the light God sent.
- Turn off the lights.
- SAY: Nicodemus was a teacher who wanted to understand God better. Jesus told him that God gives new life when people believe in Him.
- Turn on the flashlight and shine it onto the inside drawings.
- SAY: Jesus explained that God loves the whole world so much that He sent His Son, Jesus. Jesus brings light into the darkness and shows us God's love.
- SAY TOGETHER: Jesus is the light of the world!
- Add the memory verse John 13:34 to the paper.
