ACTIVITY: MEMORY VERSE REVIEW

WHAT YOU NEED: NO SUPPLIES NEEDED

What You Do:

- SAY: We've got a brand new memory verse for the month. Let's go over the motions and practice saying it together.
- Say the memory verse and do the following motions with your children.
 - "God (Flat hand with thumb to forehead, pull down) saw everything he had made (Binocular Eyes) And it was very good."
 (Two thumbs up) Genesis 1:31 (Open hands like a book)
- Review the memory verse several times together.
- SAY: The Bible teaches us that God made everything! God made you and God made me, God made everything! Who made everything? God made everything!"

PRAYER

Dear God, You are awesome! There is no one like You! Only You can make light and separate it from the darkness—we can do things in the day and at night. That is SO cool! Please help us remember that You made everything every time we go to sleep and wake up in the morning. We love You, God! In Jesus' name. Amen."



ACTIVITY: LIGHT, SKY, AND GOD IS BIG WHAT YOU NEED: NO SUPPLIES NEEDED, OPTIONAL:

What You Do:

- SAY: "Before anything was made, everything was dark. Can you cover your eyes with your hands like this? (Demonstrate) That's what it was like—super dark!" Then God said, 'Let there be light!' and there WAS light!"
- Turn on a lamp or flashlight (or just open your hands wide!)
- Say together in a loud, happy voice: "Let there be LIGHT!"
- ASK: "Can you think of something that gives us light?" "Isn't it amazing that God made light just by speaking?"
- SAY: "On the second day, God made the sky. Look up! Do you see the ceiling? Imagine that's the sky way above us."
- Stretch arms up high and say together: "God made the sky so big!"
- Pretend to make clouds with your hands—wave them like you're fluffing clouds.
- ASK: "What do you see in the sky?" (birds, clouds, stars, sun...) "Who made the sky? (God!) Can we trust someone who can do that?" (Yes!)
- SAY: "God made light and sky just by speaking.
 That means God is big and strong, and He's taking care of us. We can trust Him!"
- ASK: "Can we trust God to take care of us when it's dark or when we feel scared?" "What's something you want to talk to God about?"
